EVENT PROGRAMME:

There will be printed version of the programme for you on your arrival at the Showground.

FREE:

The event and all the activities are free. There is no charge. The only things you might need money for are to buy food and drink, to purchase any resources or to make a donation.

BAG CHECK:

In line with in-coming national legislation there will be bag checks on the way in. Please be ready so that it is all part of the fun! And pack accordingly: No metal knives or blades, weapons or explosives, glass, drones, gas burners or BBQs, alcohol, banners or flags unless related to the Church in Wales.



DOGS:

The Showground does not permit dogs other than guide dogs.

TRAVEL:

Most LMAs have a coach (for which there is no charge). Every coach saves 15-20 cars, clearly better for the environment and it adds to the hwy! Contact your clergy for details of your coach. If you travel independently, take care not to miss out on all the day has to offer.

BLUE BADGE:

There will be designated parking for blue badge holders.

WEATHER:

Pretty much everything is under cover, with just short distances between tents and the main venue, but an extra layer might be sensible as well as the sun hat!

FOOD:

There are various food outlets and a tea/coffee stand. You can bring a packed punch if you prefer. There will be space in the resources tent to sit round a table.

VOLUNTEERS NEEDED:

The more volunteers we have the more straightforward the day will be. We are looking in particular for the following
